Application source code tag in Git

To customize an application, you can retrieve the application's source code from Ellucian's public repository (Git) to your own repository. A tag is required for identifying the application's source code in the Git repository.

The source code for Position Description 9.1 is tagged as release-positiondesc-9.1 in the Git repository.

Changes to format of exported data

External applications might want to process position description information from the Position Description application for activities such as recruitment. Export functionality allows you to export position description data to a .zip file that consists of text files.

These text files contain information such as Certifications, Examinations, Education, Skills, and Responsibilities required for a position.

In the release earlier to Position Description 9.1, the position descriptions in the library were exported to a .csv file.
