Every student in the Aviation Program is required to have an FAA Medical

Certificate Second Class. This is a physical conducted by an FAA medical examiner (AME) who will check out your physical health, mental health, and criminal background history. It MUST be done by an AME; you cannot go to your regular doctor. A Second Class Medical is good for one year from the date that it is issued, and usually costs you about \$100. Note: Fixed-Wing applicants interested in the SkyWest Pilot Pathway Program are encouraged to get a <u>First</u> Class Medical, as this will be required later.
